

Broadband Advisory Report August 2022

- **The Broadband Committee presented three design options to the Town Board on August 8, The design that was selected incorporated yellow squares and a black border. Several edits were requested.**
- **Cheryl Rogers sent the approved design to the Columbia County Printers. She also requested the printing of address labels. A purchase of stamps was made.**
- **The postcard costs were \$108.50 printing, labels \$56.80, postage \$308 (700 stamps)/\$289 the unused returned to Cheryl for town use. \$454.30 total cost.**
- **The post cards and labels were completed and Nancy Rutter and Chris Tallackson picked them from Cheryl.**
- **Betsy Albert, Nancy Rutter and Chris Tallackson met at the Town Hall on August 29 to put address labels and stamps On 653 post cards. Chris had scrubbed the labels, multiple properties owned by one owner, undeveloped and seasonal properties.**
- **All the part cards were mailed on August 29.**
- **Doug Craig posted the messaging on the Gazette.**
- **Additionally, it is worth noting that the social Security Administration had sent to an email informing people of these programs.**
