**Taghkanic CAC MINUTES**

Meeting was on Thursday Jan 16, 2017 at Kadish home from 5-6:30 PM

Frost reported that he had gone to the County CAC meeting in Ancram to represent Taghkanic and that they had discussed different CAC activities in Columbia County. Frost had met Peter Paden of the CLC and was quite impressed by CLC information.

Anna presented information about the upcoming Taghkanic CAC talk about culverts for Saturday March 8. That will be given by Megan Lung. Future Taghkanic talks were discussed. These may be given by local citizens about Hudsonia, and other subjects etc. One will be on the Wild Turkeys in our area. The talk will be given by someone suggested by John Roberts who was supposed to do this last year, but this did not work out. We will try to do this sometime in the next year.

Next we discussed other possible lectures, Frost suggested that a good subject might be about the Iron Forges, which were present in Taghkanic and other local Columbia County towns in the past. We also mentioned that the History of Taghkanic would be of interest for talks. This might include studies of the Livingston family, the former Native American settlers of our area, the Taghkanic basket makers/weavers with baskets made from white ash and the previous economy of Taghkanic, etc.

We will also speak with Claudia and Conrad Vispo about possible talks to be given in the future. We then talked about our hike/walk planned for the spring which will be on April 22 on the Kadish property on Snyderstown Road in Taghkanic and will be led by Gretchen Stevens.

The next walk planned will be on other Taghkanic properties to be determined.
