- 1) The minutes for the March meeting were accepted
- 2) The Wally Farms visit was reviewed. All were impressed with the efforts for container farming, hempcrete insulation, and the various founding farmer research projects. With the purchase of the Rt 82 diner and support of projects in the City of Hudson, Wally Farms is a very positive presence in Taghkanic.
- 3) There was little follow up on the Ampion project. Subscribers were asked to keep committee members informed re progress.
- 4) The EV charging effort is awaiting further input from the DEC re grants and was looking at various funding possibilities. Also, technology advances in the next few years will undoubtedly change funding issues. Hard to predict these, but hopefully the monetary effects can be mitigated.
- 5) There was considerable discussion about repair clinics. There will be a county wide clinic at the Chatham Fair Grounds in July. We will help spread the word.
- 6) The Trees For Tribes event will be Saturday May 14. About 40 trees will be planted behind Town Hall. Volunteers will hopefully bring shovels and help.
- 7) In collaboration with The Claverack Library, there will be a "water" event held in the Taghkanic Fire Co parking lot on June 5th at 4 PM. Details will follow. Some discussion of the Taghkanic Creek Headwaters project may be involved
- 8) A discussion of crypto currency and crypto-mining and the huge electricity needs for these processes was held. More info was required.
- 9) The May meeting will be Thursday the 26th at 4 PM. It will probably be hybrid.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:10.
