

## Traffic Safety Board Report

The Columbia County Traffic Safety Board met on January 28, 2016.

The Town of Taghkanic had no matters before the Board.

Other matters before the Board were the on-going issue with the speed limit on Route 9 north of the traffic circle in Valatie; reduced speed limit requests in Kinderhook, Copake and Hillsdale, and approved speed reductions on County Route 7A, Anthony Street, and Chrysler Pond Road, all in Copake.

The Board discussed the need for high-visibility clothing for emergency responders at accident scenes (especially at night). These requirements are outlined in Section 6 of the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices Manual.

I will be contacting the Department of Transportation Maintenance Residency in Hudson to ask that they send a representative to our meetings since issues often come up that could readily be addressed by a DOT rep.

The next meeting of the Columbia County Traffic Safety Board will be on March 24, 2016 at the Public Safety Building in Hudson.
