

Traffic Safety Board Report

The Columbia County Traffic Safety Board met on July 26, 2018. I was unable to attend the meeting since I was on vacation out of state, but I received a meeting summary from the office of the Canaan Highway Superintendent.

NYS Police Capt. Mike Jankowiak has been reassigned; Captain Kathryn Rohde will serve on the TSB for the State Police.

NYS DOT Assistant Resident Engineer Rick Frick informed the TSB that work on Route 203 has been completed. DOT is now paving Route 9 south of the City of Hudson and the Route 9 & 23 overlap at Bells Pond, as well as Route 9 to the Roeliff Jansenkil. The NY State Police will monitor traffic at the work zone.

Work will begin on the new round-about on the east side of the Rip VanWinkle Bridge in early August.

The next meeting of the Columbia County Traffic Safety Board is scheduled for September 27, 2018, and will be held at the Paul Proper Public Safety Building in Hudson, beginning at 7 p.m.
