

Columbia County Traffic Safety Board Report

The Columbia County Traffic Safety Board met at the Public Safety Building in Hudson on Thursday, July 22, 2021.

The Board voted unanimously to maintain the current Officers for another year. They are:

- Vice-Chair Henry Swartz
- Recording Secretary Linda Swartz

The Executive Secretary, who is not elected, but rather is an appointed county employee, is Tim Nixon.

The request for reduced speed limit on Taghkanic-Churchtown Road was sent to NYSDOT, along with 12 others, in July. We are awaiting response.

Construction has begun on West Taghkanic Bridge and is expected to be completed by November. Woodward Bridge on CR 7 in Gallatin is postponed until next year due to supply issues with precast members.

The TSB will send a contribution to a breast cancer organization in memory of Dean Knox. The County has yet to appoint someone to replace Dean.

Once the ADA elevator to second floor is installed and operational, we will be able to have TSB meetings there. Henry will keep us advised.

It was mentioned that this election year will bring new Highway Superintendents to five towns in Columbia County, largely due to the retirement of current Highway Superintendents.
